Abbreviations & Information: Main Building - includes Reception, Operon - sometimes referred to as the Annex Building, LAR - Laboratory Animal Resources, Canteen - sometimes referred to as Casino, serving hot food at lunch, NMR - Nuclear Magnetic Resonance, ALMF - Advanced Light Microscopy Facility. Some buildings are linked through lower level not shown on this map.

The meeting will take place in the **EMBL Advanced Training Centre (ATC)**, located on the EMBL campus. Please follow the outside signage to the ATC building. If you are reaching the ATC through the footpath from the Car Parking P1 to the Courtyard Entrance, please make sure to visit the registration desk (located at the main ATC entrance), to pick up your badge.

Arriving by plane:

[Frankfurt International Airport \(FRA\)](#) is the closest and most convenient airport for Heidelberg.

Frankfurt International Airport is connected to Heidelberg [via train](#). Hint: A Flexpreis ticket ensures you can take any train that day.

Alternatively, the [Airport Shuttle Bus](#) from Frankfurt International Airport to Heidelberg leaves from Terminal 1 (Arrivals - Level B Meeting Point, close to Exit B3), and upon request, Terminal 2 arriving at multiple hotels in Heidelberg city centre. Please reserve your seat at least nine days in advance to benefit from an early booking discount.

Arriving by train:

Heidelberg Hauptbahnhof (main train station) is located close to the city centre. There are express services to all countries in Europe as well as regional trains - [Train schedules](#).

Arriving by car:

From the A5 motorway (Karlsruhe-Frankfurt) take the Heidelberg-Schwetzingen exit and head towards Heidelberg-Boxberg-Emmertgrund. Go up the hill, turn left at the Aral petrol station into Boxberg.

From the A6 motorway (Mannheim-Heilbronn) take the Wiesloch-Rauenberg exit and follow the signs to Heidelberg (B3). You will reach a fork in the road where you stay to the right, direction Boxberg-Emmertgrund. Go up the hill, turn left at the Aral petrol station into Boxberg.

Public transport:

Direct [public transport](#) to EMBL is available from Heidelberg main station (Bus 28 from stop "L" in the direction of "Emmertgrund" or "Mombertplatz") – travel time ca. 15 minutes. Tickets can be bought from ticket machines or from the bus driver.

Conference shuttle:

For your convenience, we have arranged bus transfers between the city centre and EMBL, as well as between EMBL and the ISG Hotel located on Boxberg. Please check this [map](#) for the nearest bus stop to your hotel. Buses are operated by the company "Hoffmann Reisen". Schedules will be made available closer to the conference dates.

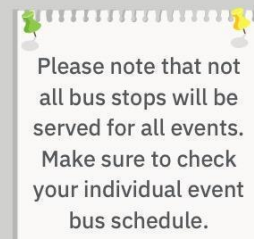
